The Paris City Commission met in a special session at 8:45 a.m. on Tuesday, May 23, 2017.

Mayor, Thornton called the session to order.

City Clerk, Stephanie Settles conducted roll call. Jordan stated a listing of the roadways in need of paving will be prepared and reviewed at a future meeting.
