CITY OF PARIS ORDINANCE 2023-11

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CITY OF PARIS AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2023-2024 ON PERSONAL PROPERTY, OTHER THAN MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT, WITHIN THE TAXING JUDISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PARIS SHALL BE AT THE PARE OF

TAXING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PARIS SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$0.1806 PER ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION.

Be it ordained by the City of Paris:

Section I: That for the purpose of general support of the government of the City of

Paris, and the payment of its debts and expenses for the fiscal year 2023-2024, there be and

hereby, are levied ad valorem taxes on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of the January 1,

2023 assessed valuation by the Bourbon County Property Valuation Administrator of all

personal property, other than motor vehicles and watercraft, within the taxing jurisdiction of the

City of Paris, which shall be at the rate of \$0.1806.

Section II: All taxes not paid by the 29<sup>th</sup> day of December 2023 shall be subject to

a penalty of ten percent (10%) plus interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum.

Section III: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in full as

required by law, with an effective date of July 1, 2023.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced and read for the first time at the City Commission's

regular meeting of August 22, 2023. Read for the second time, adopted, and approved at its

special meeting of September 14, 2023.
