Pursuant to KRS 61.826 and OAG 20-05, the state of emergency regarding the threats to public health presented by the novel coronavirus (covid-19) pandemic. This meeting of the Paris city commission was conducted by videoconference. The Paris City Commission met in regular session by Webex video conference at 9:00 a.m. viewable on Facebook live at www.facebook.com/cityofparisky/ on Tuesday, July 28, 2020.

Mayor, John Plummer called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

City Clerk, Stephanie Settles conducted roll call.

Upon determining a quorum was present for the transaction of business, City Manager, Daron Jordan, proceeded to conduct the meeting.

Approve Minutes

Motion by Brooks, seconded by Plummer, approving the minutes of July 14, 2020 regular meeting. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Perraut, Brooks, Galbraith, and Allen-Edwards voting Aye.

Old Rusiness

CITY OF PARIS RESOLUTION 2020-2

ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARIS CITY COMMISSION ("CITY") AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND ("CRF") APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF INCURRED EXPENSES IN CRF FUNDS WITH THE DEPARTMENT FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT ("DLG"); AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS WHICH ARE DEEMED NECESSARY BY DLG TO REIMBURSE THE CITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACT AS THE AUTHORIZED CORRESPONDENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT.

WHEREAS, City of Paris desires reimbursement for expenses incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") on behalf of the residents of Paris, KY; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that CRF funds are available to the City, pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), and impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the City that require among other things:

- (1) Approval of a satisfactory application by the City transmitted to DLG for approval; and
- (2) Other obligations of the City in connection with receiving the CRF funds for the purposes stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved this the 28th day of July 2020, by the City of Paris City Commission

That a CRF application on behalf of the City for CRF funds for reimbursement of expenses incurred by City due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19 shall be submitted to DLG; the Mayor, or designee, shall provide such additional information and furnish such documentation as may be required; and authorize the Mayor, or designee, to act as the authorized correspondent for reimbursement.

New Business

Daron Jordan stated the City had received a request to adopt an Ordinance and post signs indicating "No Jake Brake" areas within the City limits. City Attorney Bryan Beauman stated there are KRS state statues that can be used for enforcement of Jake Brake by state and local officers. Local ordinances are superseded by state statue. No action was required by the Commission.

Motion by Perraut, seconded by Plummer, approving the part-time hire of Kim Bozarth as a Single Role Paramedic, and full-time Firefighter EMT positions to Steve Linville, and Charles Curtz. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Perraut, Brooks, Galbraith, and Allen-Edwards voting Aye.

Motion by Galbraith, seconded by Perraut, approving June financials as presented by Brad Oberlander, reflecting General Fund Revenues of \$9,468,973.00 with expenditures of \$8,548,713.00 Utility Fund Revenues of \$10,335,357.00 with expenditures of \$10,250,003.00. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Allen-Edwards, Galbraith, Brooks, Perraut, and Plummer voting Aye.
