The following repairs need to made on a 1973 Fairbanks Morse model 3800TDD8-1/8:

- Inspect Jacket Water system to verify cause of water leak in exhaust area
- Remove top cover
- Remove upper oil jumpers
- Remove upper main bearing caps
- Remove upper crankshaft
- Remove upper rod & piston assembly of liner to be replaced
- Remove lower rod & piston assembly of liner to be replaced
- Dis-assemble rod & piston assemblies.

Requalify all components to OEM specifications or replace as necessary

- Inspect vertical drive assemblies; rebuild as necessary
- Remove cylinder liner
- Clean air box, exhaust belts, fuel deck areas, etc.
- Install new cylinder liner with new O-rings, etc.
- Re-install upper rod & piston assembly with new rings
- Re-install lower rod & piston assembly with new rings
- Inspect, clean, upper crankshaft
- Install upper crankshaft
- Install upper main bearing caps; install requalified bearings, replace as necessary
- Install upper oil jumpers
- Install top cover
- Provide and install new adapters,
