A MUNICIPAL ORDER APPROVING THE MAYOR'S REAPPOINTMENT OF JASON DAILEY TO THE TO THE BOURBON COUNTY JOINT PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION FOR A TERM ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2028.

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement for the Joint Planning & Zoning Commission authorizes the Mayor to make appointment of five positions to the Bourbon County Joint Planning & Zoning Commission. Such shall be confirmed by the Commission.

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement does not indicate a term length but the current term length of that seat has been a period of four years.

WHEREAS, the City has adopted Ordinance No 2019-13 which establishes limits for consecutive terms.

WHEREAS, the current term of the appointee is set to expire December 31, 2024 and he has not met the maximum number of consecutive appointments;

WHEREAS, the Mayor is recommending reappointment;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Paris that the Mayor's reappointment of Jason Dailey to the Bourbon County Joint Planning & Zoning Commission for a term ending December 31, 2028.
