Title: Ground Technician (Apprentice Line Technician)

Status: Full Time (2 open positions)

WHO MAY BE CONSIDERED:

Any applicant with some experience in the electrical field with a High school diploma or equivalent.

JOB SUMMARY:

Under close supervision, performs apprentice-level ground work in the construction and maintenance of electrical distribution systems; and does related work as required. This position requires knowledge of the principles and practices of Electric Distribution. Knowledge of the tools and equipment used and preventative maintenance practices.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Assists in erecting, removing, and climbing poles, towers, steel and related structures. Assists in assembling, installing, removing, and transferring such line hardware and electrical equipment as transformers, cross-arms, insulators, lightning arrestor, guy cables, and related equipment. Trims and removes trees. Assists in installation and maintenance of underground residential distribution. Assists in loading, unloading and operating wire pulling equipment. Assists in repairing breakdowns. Assists in all other departments when necessary. May assist in power plant operator duties. Performs connects/disconnects for services, daily. Works on call hours on a rotating schedule.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High school or GED equivalent Electric vocation school recommended but not required
- Valid Kentucky driver's license - CDL or the ability to obtain one
- Physically fit
- Lifting 50lbs frequently 100+lbs on occasion

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Familiarity with basic electricity operations. Working knowledge of safety procedures. Ability to work in inclement weather. Ability to establish and maintain effective work relationships with employees, superiors, and the public. Dependability. Sound judgment. Alertness. Integrity.
